

## KS1 Unit 9, Lesson 10: Death and resurrection of Jesus.

**Context:** This lesson explores Bible story of the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus in the context of the wider Easter story.

**Overview:** To find out what the bible says about the Crucifixion and the Resurrection of Jesus.

**Essential core:**

- Recall stories from the Bible associated with the last eight days of Jesus' life, including (a) his entry into Jerusalem, (b) the Last Supper, (c) his arrest, **(d) crucifixion and (e) resurrection.** (AMV units 2,3,9).
- Identify these stories with the religion of Christianity, who are collectively called Christians and know that they are from the Bible.
- Recognise the order of the key events in the Biblical narrative.
- Raise and suggest answers to relevant questions in response to their enquiry into the Easter story.

### INTRODUCTION:

Discuss the previous two lessons Palm Sunday and the Last Supper and the arrest of Jesus. Can you recall what happened during the journey to Jerusalem? Talk with your partner, then some children share with the class. Can you list three things that happened during the Last Supper? Talk with your partner, then some different children share with the class.

### BUILD UP:

The next part of the Easter story is very important for Christians because they believe that Jesus died to carry away all their failings and short comings (illustrate with a book in one hand and moving book over to other hand). This part of the Easter story starts off quite sad but soon becomes very happy. Watch the Crucifixion video. How would you describe how Jesus friends felt during the crucifixion? Can you recall what the army officer said about Jesus? Watch the resurrection video. How did the women feel when they went into the empty tomb? How would you describe how the women felt when they saw the angels? Can you remember any other times angels appeared to people in the bible? (Mary and shepherds in the first Christmas). Can you recall other people who saw Jesus after he had risen? How do you think they felt?

Show children the pictures of the main events of the Easter story from the printable sheet on RE:quest webpage. Order the pictures as a class matching the statements correctly. Discuss the events.

### TASK:

LA to stick the pictures in order and write captions for each picture.

MA to order all the pictures writing sentences for each picture.

HA to order all pictures writing detailed sentences for each picture.

### FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT:

Can children order the five main events of the Easter Story correctly?
