The books of the Tenakh (Jewish Holy Books) are the same as the Old Testament of the Protestant Christian Bible. They are broken into three parts.

1. Torah (Pentatuch). The first five books, Genesis-Deuteronomy, traditionally written by Moses.
2. Navi (Prophets). Joshua-1, 2 Kings, Isaiah-Ezekiel 7 | Hosea-Malachi.
3. Ketuvim (Writings). Psalms, Proverbs, Job, Song of Songs, Ruth, Lamentations, Ecclesiastes, Esther, Daniel, Ezra-Nehemiah, Chronicles.

The Talmud

The Talmud is over 6,200 pages long. It is written in Hebrew and Aramaic and contains the teachings and opinions of thousands of rabbis on a variety of subjects, The Talmud is the basis for all codes of Jewish Law.
